

PROMOTERS CONDITIONS

1. This competition will be held under ASA laws and ASA technical rules.
2. All events will start at the deep end of the pool.
3. Over the top starts may operate at the discretion of the lead referee and the meet management.
4. This meet has been licensed at level 2 (2SEXXXXX)
5. Age groups for this meet will be age as at 27th April 2008.
6. This meet is subject to upper & lower qualifying times and entries that fall outside these times will be rejected. However, at the meet management's discretion, those swimmers who are rejected for this reason may be allowed to swim for time only where space permits.
7. Prospective competitors must be registered (or have applied for registration) with the ASA to enable them to compete in this meet.
8. Entries for this event will be managed as follows:
 - A) All events will be seeded based on entry times.
 - B) Each individual age group will be given a proportion of the event based on the number of valid entries received, although age groups are combined (see program of events).
 - C) At the meet management's discretion, shortfalls in one age group may be made up by swims in another age group.
 - D) Priority will be given to clubs who submit their entries electronically (Team Manager Lite)
 - E) Late entries or slowest entry times may be rejected.
9. The closing date for entries is 31st March 2008.
10. Clubs / Competitors are expected to submit correct and official entry times. To ensure that this competition is fair any swimmer / club found to be submitting incorrect or false times may be removed from the meet. In this case no refund of entry fees will be due.
11. This meet will operate without cards. LSC will make available on our Open Meet Website a summary of accepted & where necessary rejected entries. Where it has been necessary to restrict entries, a refund will be given and available for coaches / team managers to pick up at the event.
12. The pool
 - A) Is 25 meters (Short Course)
 - B) Has 6 Lanes
 - C) Has Anti-turbulence lane ropes
13. Colorado Electronic Timing will be used for this meet.
14. The age groups for this meet are 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs,14yrs, 15yrs, 16yrs & over.
15. The pool will be available for warm up before the start of each session as displayed in the program. Warm up will be controlled by the senior warm up marshal. Coaches / Team Mangers of each club are responsible for ensuring that their swimmers follow the guidelines laid down, act responsibly & warm up in the time allotted for their age group & sex.
16. Each event will incorporate all age groups as promoted (using submitted times to seed) and winners will be decided on HDW (heat declared winner) for all events. There are no finals.
17. For each heat, lanes will be spearheaded.
18. Time only swims may be allowed at the meet managements discretion and where space allows.

19. The first 6 swimmers in each event in each age group will receive awards. Awards can be collected from the trophy table during the course of the meet. Awards not collected will not be sent on.
20. All competitors' cards must be posted in the boxes provided by no later than the time displayed for that session as detailed in The Event Program. Failure to do so may result in the swimmer not being accepted for that event.
21. Swimmers **must** report to the whipping area when instructed to do so. Any competitor not reporting in time may be excluded.
22. **Coaches:** Passes must be applied for with the entry forms. Coach passes include admission to swimmers gallery, programs (plus one full set of results), food between the sessions and entry to poolside during warm up sessions. Passes can be collected, on the day, from the admissions entry point. Only those with coaches' passes will be allowed on the swimmers side of the gallery and on poolside during warm up sessions.
23. **Data Protection:** Meet entries & results will be held and managed on a computer. Your consent to the holding of personal information for the purpose of this meet is deemed to be given by the submission of your entry to Littlehampton Swimming Club
24. **Payment:** Must be made on a single club cheque made payable to Littlehampton Swimming Club.
25. **Results:** These will be displayed on the upper gallery on each side of both the spectator and swimmers entry point. Copies of result sheets are available for purchase at 20 pence per sheet. **Results will be available on our website (www.littlehampton-sc.ik.com) at the end of each day.**
26. **Swim Down:** The small pool may be used by swimmers to swim down after their race at the discretion of the meet management. Each swimmer may only remain in the small pool for the duration of the next race. The swim down **MUST NOT** interfere with the main event. Any swimmer not complying with these rules will be removed from the water by the meet management or pool staff and the facility of the swim down will cease for ALL swimmers.
27. **Video Recording / Photography / Mobile Telephones:** In accordance with the ASA Child protection policy, we respectfully ask for your co-operation, and any person wishing to record on video, use zoom lens photography equipment, or use a mobile telephone with photographic capabilities to photograph any of the activities at today's meet, shall provide their name and address with the meet management at the admissions desk. A label will be issued to identify them as having the meet management's permission, which must be displayed in a visible position. It is also requested that all mobiles are switched off or to silent during the competition and that no flash photography is used at the start of each race.
28. **SECURITY:** Competitors are advised not to leave their belongings unattended. Neither Littlehampton S.C. nor The Victoria Centre Management can accept responsibility for any property that is either lost or stolen.
29. The meet management reserve the right to remove any spectators or swimmers from the pool whose behavior is either against the swimming centre rules or the efficient running of the meet.
30. The meet management reserves the right to amend the program to ensure the timely running of the meet.
31. Any matters not covered by these conditions will be dealt with in accordance with the laws of the sport and at discretion of the meet management. By submitting an entry participants have deemed to agree to such decisions.
